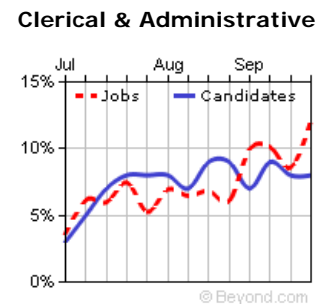
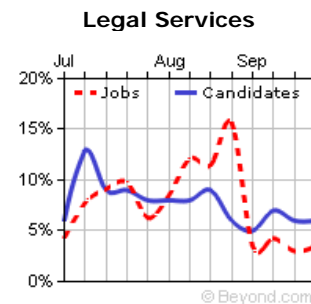
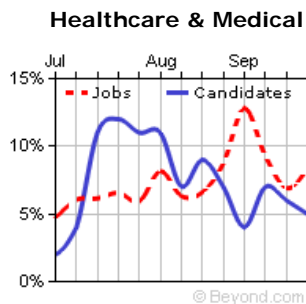
Dear Reader:

Beyond.com is pleased to present our Career Trend Analysis Report for third quarter 2008, which highlights online job posting and candidate resume trends across our network of more than 15,000 career communities. Each quarter, we showcase these market trends, as well as report on a variety of candidate attributes such as experience level, length of job search, and ethnicity across more than 25 separate industries. These attributes are important in demonstrating the skill level, freshness and diversification of our candidates to corporations, agencies and hiring managers. This report is also helpful to business professionals and job seekers who want to stay informed and track trends within their area of interest or work.

Unemployment is on the rise, the stock market has taken a tumble and the housing crisis is still very much a crisis. Regardless of where you turn, you hear about the economic recession and its ongoing impact on the job market with no expected recovery in the short term. Now more than ever, it is important that we continue to closely monitor job and candidate activity across various industries to identify and predict marketplace fluctuations and opportunities occurring in the U.S. job market. Located below are just a few of our key findings as a result of our third quarter 2008 review:

Online Job Postings

- Healthcare & Medical, for the very first time since third quarter 2006, gained the #1 spot for online job postings with 12.92%, over Information Technology which was the previous leader for the past six consecutive quarters. This industry also exhibited the largest percentage gain over the past 12 months with 2.66%. Since the Healthcare & Medical industry is not as affected by the current housing, credit and financial crisis as some industries, it is no surprise that it has remained strong and continues to add jobs to address the growing needs of the aging population, support medical advancements and continued focus on nursing and preventive care. For employers looking to attract experienced workers in this field, they need to be creative with their benefit packages and be willing to offer flexible schedules, tuition reimbursement, etc.
- Two additional industries that experienced a significant increase in job postings were Legal Services (0.90%) and Clerical & Administrative (0.87%). In addition, these two industries exhibited the second and third largest percentage gain over the past 12 months.



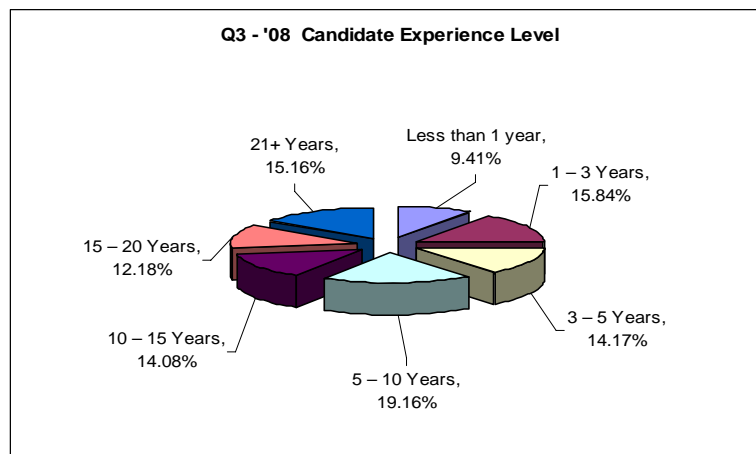
- From a state perspective, Nebraska ranked as the #4 state with the largest percentage of online job postings per capita with 3.06%. Nebraska also exhibited the largest percentage increase over the previous quarter with 0.48% and over the past 12 months, the state experienced the second largest percentage gain with 0.76%.
- Healthcare & Medical was noted as the top industry within seven metropolitan regions. The New York-Northern New Jersey-Long Island metro region was remained as the top region

for online job postings with 18.45%. In addition, this region was represented as the top metro region within 15 industries.

Online Resume Posting

- In third quarter 2008, the top two industries for online resume postings remained consistent from the previous quarter. Clerical & Administrative dominated with 33.82% and Customer Service remained strong with 11.94%. Healthcare & Medical jumped two spots to take the #3 position for the first time with 10.75%. Although candidate numbers are climbing in Healthcare & Medical, the number of jobs still outweighs candidates thereby signifying a "healthy" industry.
- Accounting & Finance and Manufacturing & Production both exhibited major decreases in resumes over the past quarter and year. Accounting & Finance had the largest percentage decrease over the previous quarter with -2.99% and the second largest decline over the past year with -2.69%. Manufacturing & Production had the third largest percentage decrease over the previous quarter with -1.70% and the largest percentage decrease over the past year with -2.91%. Information Technology held the second major decrease this quarter with -2.48%.
- On a state level, Florida exhibited a significant strength in online resume postings. Florida was ranked as the #2 state with the largest percentage of online resume postings per capita for the third quarter. In addition, the state had the largest percentage gain over the previous quarter with 1.55% and 1.91% over the past year. Florida has continuously grown in resume postings due to many candidates, especially retirees who are returning to the workforce, yet still relocating to the state for the warmer climate.
- For the first time, Atlanta jumped two positions to gain the #1 spot for online resume postings with 14.39%. Another significant change was in the Miami-Fort Lauderdale metro region which gained the #3 spot, up from the #7 spot last quarter. Within both of these metro regions, Clerical & Administrative was the top industry and Healthcare & Medical was the second top industry.

Our Network of Candidates



- We continue to show strength in the quality and freshness of our network candidates. Our statistics show that 60% of candidates have 5 or more years of experience and over 62% have been searching for a job within one month. Since competition is strong for the best positions, especially in such a tight labor market, candidates should focus on gaining more on-the-job experience and consider furthering their education in order to stay ahead and differentiate themselves from other candidates in their field.

- In reviewing the top three industries for online job postings, we noted that 49% of Healthcare & Medical, 63% of Information Technology, and almost 81% of Sales & Sales Management candidates had 5 or more years of experience. In addition, we expect the level of candidates with 21+ years of experience to gradually increase since more Americans are choosing to work past retirement as a result of their retirement funds being squeezed by a looming economy. According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, over the next decade the number of workers 55 and older is expected to increase by more than five times the rate of the overall workforce.
- We also noted that over 43% of our network candidates are members of a minority group with African Americans representing the largest minority with 23.28%.
- The majority of executive level candidates held the job title of Director with 26.92%. The Western region continued to represent the majority of executive level candidates with 27.34% and the industry with the largest percentage of executive level candidates was once again Information Technology with 15.57%.

These statistics are just a small sample of online job and resume posting trends we have uncovered in third quarter 2008. 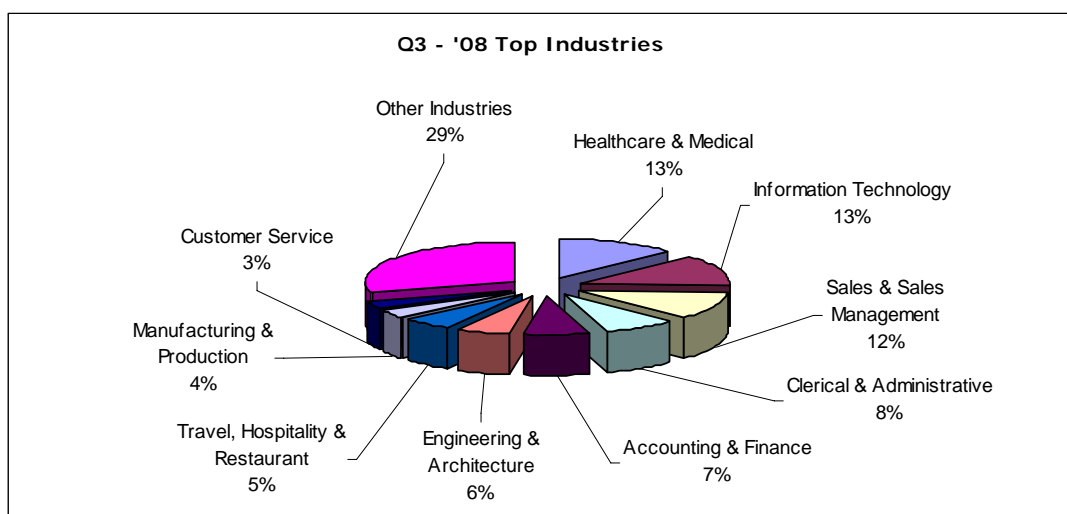
Job Posting Development and Trends:

Industry

For the first time, Healthcare & Medical gained the top spot for online job postings with 12.92% over Information Technology, which was the previous leader for the past six consecutive quarters. Information Technology dropped to the #2 spot with 12.90%, only 0.02% behind Healthcare & Medical. Sales & Sales Management remained in the #3 spot with 11.65%, while Clerical & Administrative jumped to the #4 spot with 7.92% over Accounting & Finance, now #5 with 7.07%.

Over the previous quarter, the industries with the largest percentage gain in online job postings included: Legal Services (0.90%), Clerical & Administrative (0.87%), and Customer Service (0.54%). On the other hand, the industries with the largest percentage decrease over the previous quarter included: Travel, Hospitality & Restaurant (-1.31%), Information Technology (-1.09%), and Sales & Sales Management (-0.97%).

In reviewing our network statistics, we assessed overall industry growth in online job postings over the past 12 months and the industries with the largest percentage increase included: Healthcare & Medical (2.66%), Clerical & Administrative (1.68%), and Legal Services (1.34%). The industries with the largest percentage decrease included: Management & Business (-4.99%), Travel, Hospitality & Restaurant (-1.64%), and Accounting & Finance (-1.51%).

State & Regional

On a state level, the states with the largest percentage of online job postings per capita in third quarter 2008 included: 1) The District of Columbia, 2) Connecticut, 3) Massachusetts, 4) Nebraska, a new entrant, and 5) Montana. In analyzing the top states with each industry channel, the District of Columbia remained strong in the #1 spot within 16 industries.

Over the previous quarter, the states with the largest percentage of job growth included: Nebraska (0.48%), Rhode Island (0.39%), and New Mexico (0.28%). The states with the largest percentage decrease in online jobs over the previous quarter included: Connecticut (-0.77%), California (-0.36%), and the District of Columbia (-0.36%). In looking at our 12 month view, West Virginia once again exhibited the largest percentage gain with 1.10%, followed by Nebraska (0.76%) and

Wyoming (0.62%). The District of Columbia experienced the largest percentage decrease for the second consecutive quarter with -2.55%, followed by Utah (-0.61%), and Maine (-0.48%).

In assessing our regional data, Sales & Sales Management was the top industry in the Southern and Western regions, while Healthcare & Medical ranked as the #2 industry. Information Technology ranked as the top industry in the Mid Atlantic region with Sales & Sales Management as the #2 industry. In the Mid Western region, Sales & Sales Management tied with Healthcare & Medical as the top industry and in the Northeastern region, Sales & Sales Management tied with Accounting & Finance and Information Technology as the top industry.

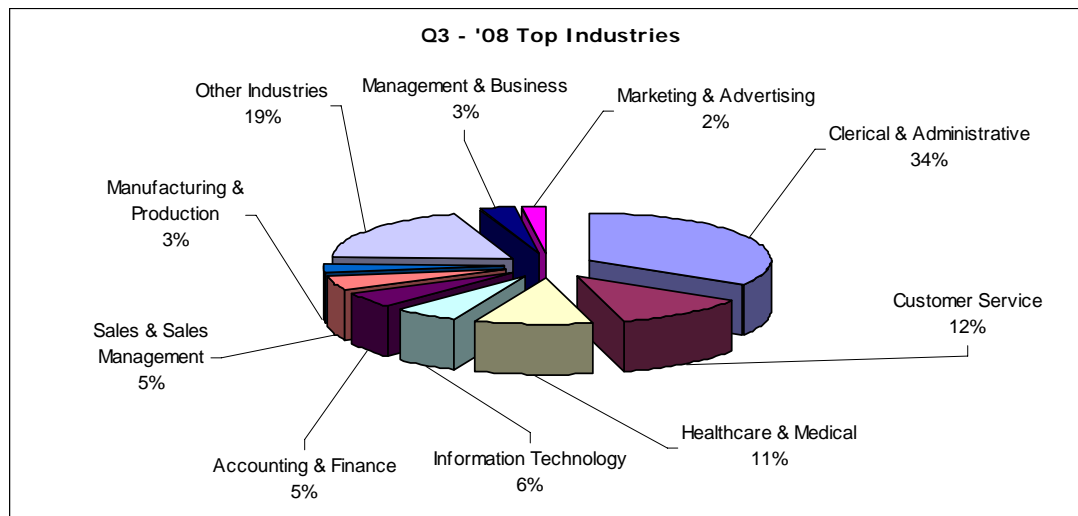
Resume Posting Development and Trends:

Industry

From an online resume posting perspective, Clerical & Administrative (33.82%) and Customer Service (11.94%) remained in the top two positions for online resume postings. However there was a change in the #3 spot. Healthcare & Medical jumped from the #5 position last quarter to take the #3 spot with 10.75%. With the remaining top 10 positions, the only change occurred in the #5 and #9 spots. Accounting and Finance dropped from the #3 spot to the #5 spot. Marketing & Advertising took the #9 spot, eliminating Engineering & Architecture from the top 10. Engineering & Architecture represented 3.82% of resume postings in second quarter 2008.

Over the previous quarter, the industries with the largest percentage of online resume growth included: Clerical & Administrative (11.74%), Healthcare & Medical (4.62%), and Customer Service (2.59%). On the other hand, the industries with the largest percentage decrease in candidate resumes over the previous quarter included: Accounting & Finance (-2.99%), Information Technology (-2.48%), and Manufacturing & Production (-1.70%).

We evaluated overall industry growth over the past 12 months and the industries with the largest percentage of candidate growth included: Clerical & Administrative (17.18%), Healthcare & Medical (2.44%), and Customer Service (1.74%). The industries with the largest percentage decrease over the past 12 months included: Manufacturing & Production (-2.91%), Accounting & Finance (-2.69%), and Sales & Sales Management (-2.41%).

State and Regional

On a state level, the states with the largest percentage of online resume postings per capita over third quarter 2008 were: 1) Georgia, 2) Florida, 3) Nevada, 4) North Carolina, a new entrant, and 5) Arizona. In reviewing the top states within each industry channel, Georgia gained the #1 position over Nevada, the previous leader, representing 7 industries. In comparing the percentage increase over the previous quarter, the states with the largest percentage increase included: Florida (1.55%), Georgia (1.30%) and North Carolina (1.21%). Over the previous quarter, the largest percentage decrease included: Colorado (-1.25%), California (-1.09%) and New Jersey (-0.78%).

Over the past 12 months, the states with the largest percentage increase in online resumes included: Florida (1.91%), North Carolina (1.32%) and South Carolina (0.84%). The states with the largest percentage decrease included: Colorado (-1.55%), Oregon (-1.12%), and Alabama (-0.88%).

Our regional view indicates that Clerical & Administrative continued as the top industry across all metro regions except for the Southern region where it tied with Customer Service as the top industry. Customer Service was the #2 industry in the Mid Atlantic, Mid Western, and Western regions. Healthcare & Medical ranked as the #2 industry in the Northeastern and Southern region.

Candidate Developments and Trends

We continue to track and analyze candidate experience levels and length of job search across the Beyond.com Network, with a particular focus on the top 3 industries for online job postings and resume postings. Located below is a brief summary of our key findings in third quarter 2008:

Experience Level

In reviewing third quarter 2008 data, we noted that 60% of our network candidates have 5 or more years of experience. In comparing these numbers from the previous quarter, the largest percentage increase was noted in candidates with 1-3 years of experience (0.70%), while the largest percentage decrease was noted in candidates with less than one year of experience (-1.28%).

Length of Job Search

In assessing the length of candidate job search in the third quarter, the largest percentage continued to be noted in candidates who just started their job search with 37.33%. Over 62% of network candidates have been searching for a job within one month. In comparing candidates from the previous quarter, the largest percentage increase was noted in candidates who have been searching for a job within the past 2 months (0.91%), while the largest percentage decrease was noted by those who have been searching within the past 9 months (-1.01%).

Top 3 Industries for Online Job Postings

Healthcare & Medical, Information Technology, and Sales & Sales Management

In evaluating candidate experience levels for the top three industries for online job postings, 49% of candidates in Healthcare & Medical, 63% in Information Technology and almost 81% in Sales & Sales Management had 5 or more years of experience.

Top 3 Industries for Resume Postings

Clerical & Administrative, Customer Service, and Healthcare & Medical

In reviewing candidate experience level for the top three industries for online resume postings, we noted that 57% of Clerical & Administrative, 57% of Customer Service and 49% of Healthcare & Medical candidates had 5 or more years of experience.

Candidate Statistics

We are pleased to report candidate diversity and executive statistics for the Beyond.com Network.

Gender

In evaluating the gender makeup of the Beyond.com Network, we noted that 57.93% of our network candidates were female and 42.07% were male, which signifies a 2.36% increase in the male candidate population over second quarter 2008.

Age

In reviewing the age composition of our candidates, the majority of candidates (43.67%) remain in the 21-30 year age bracket, an increase of 2.01% from second quarter 2008. The second largest percentage represented candidates in the 31-40 year age bracket (22.23%) and the third largest percentage (16.13%) in the 41-50 year age bracket.

Ethnicity

In assessing the ethnicity of our network candidates, the majority of candidates continue to be White (Non-Hispanic) with 56.53%, up 4.59% from second quarter 2008. The second largest percentage (23.28%) was represented by African American/Black candidates. Asian/Pacific Islander candidates (9.45%) and Hispanic candidates (9.91%) were once again very close in percentages.

Executive Breakdown

Gender

In reviewing our top-tier executive candidates, we noted that 81.36% of executive level candidates are male, up from 81.27% in second quarter 2008 with females representing 18.64% of the Beyond.com Network.

Top Job Titles for Executives

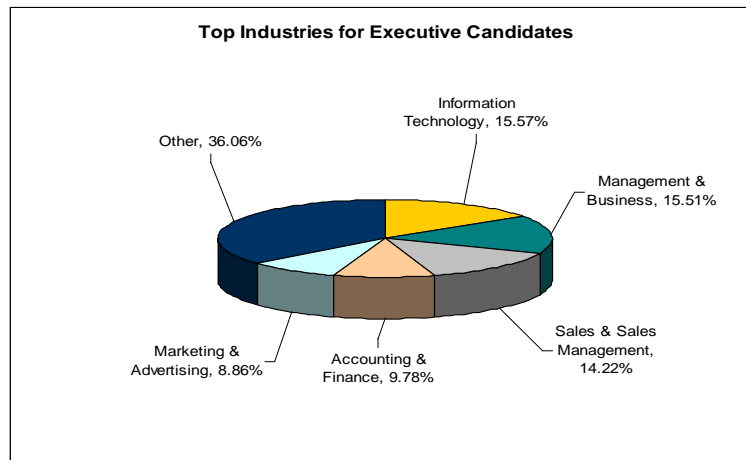
In evaluating the top job titles for executive candidates, the job title of Director exhibited the largest percentage with 26.92%. Both Vice President and Manager titles represented 25.62% of executive candidates. The lowest percentages were Chief Financial Officer (8.54%) and President (6.27%).

Geographic Breakdown

The Western region continued to represent the majority of executive level candidates with 27.34%. Close behind the West was the Southern region with 24.34%. Other regional percentages were: Mid Atlantic (18.36%), Midwest (17.63%), and the Northeast (12.33%).

Top Industries for Executive Candidates

Information Technology continued to be the top industry for executive candidates with 15.57%; however, Management & Business was very close behind with 15.51%. Other top industries for executives included: Sales & Sales Management (14.22%), Accounting & Finance (9.78%), and Marketing & Advertising (8.86%).



Top 15 Metropolitan Region Job Developments and Trends

In reviewing industry trends for the top 15 major metropolitan areas within the United States during third quarter 2008, the New York-Northern New Jersey-Long Island metropolitan area continued to hold the top spot for online job postings for the eighth consecutive quarter with 18.45%, which signifies an increase of 1.36% over the previous quarter. The second and third top regions also remained consistent; Los Angeles-Riverside-Orange County (12.51%) and San Francisco-Oakland-San Jose (11.33%).

In assessing the top industries by metropolitan region, Healthcare & Medical gained the #1 industry, over Information Technology, now the #2 industry. The New York-Northern New Jersey-Long Island region made a significant move this quarter in being the top region within 15 industries. The previous lead region, Los Angeles-Riverside-Orange County, only represented four industries this quarter, along with the San Francisco-Oakland-San Jose region.

In comparing the metropolitan regions over the past 12 months, the only positions that experienced a shift was in the #8, #9, #11, and #12 positions. The regions that experienced a jump were Atlanta (#9 to #8) and Miami-Fort Lauderdale (#12 to #11). The regions that exhibited a decrease in position were Boston-Worcester-Lawrence (#8 to #9) and Phoenix-Mesa (#11 to #12).

Top 15 Metropolitan Region Resume Posting Developments and Trends

In evaluating industry trends in third quarter 2008 for the top 15 metropolitan regions in the United States, there were some notable shifts this period. Atlanta gained the #1 spot with 14.39%, a jump of two spots from the previous quarter. In addition, New York-Northern New Jersey-Long Island declined to the #2 spot. The most significant change was the Miami-Fort Lauderdale region which gained the #3 spot, up from the #7 spot last quarter.

In reviewing the top industries by metropolitan region, Clerical & Administrative was the #1 industry for the fifth consecutive quarter, while Healthcare & Medical was the #2 industry. The New York-Northern New Jersey-Long Island region remained as the top metropolitan region within 17 industries.

In comparing the top metropolitan regions over the past 12 months, once again majority of the positions remained steady. The regions that experienced a shift included: Atlanta (#3 to #2), Los Angeles-Riverside-Orange County (#2 to #3), Miami-Fort Lauderdale (#7 to #6), and Philadelphia-Wilmington-Atlantic City (#6 to #7).

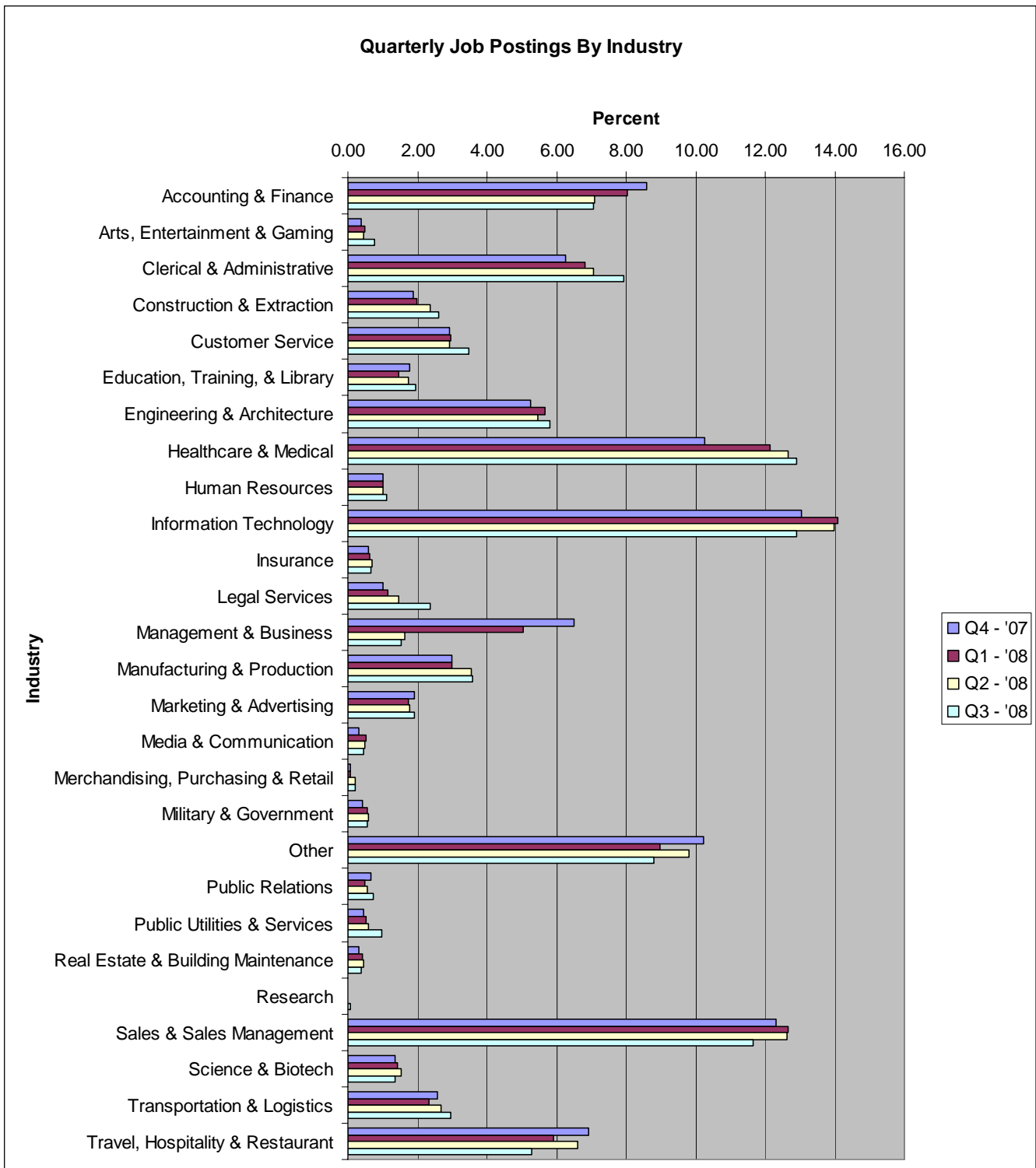


Figure 1: Job Postings by Industry (Q407-Q308)

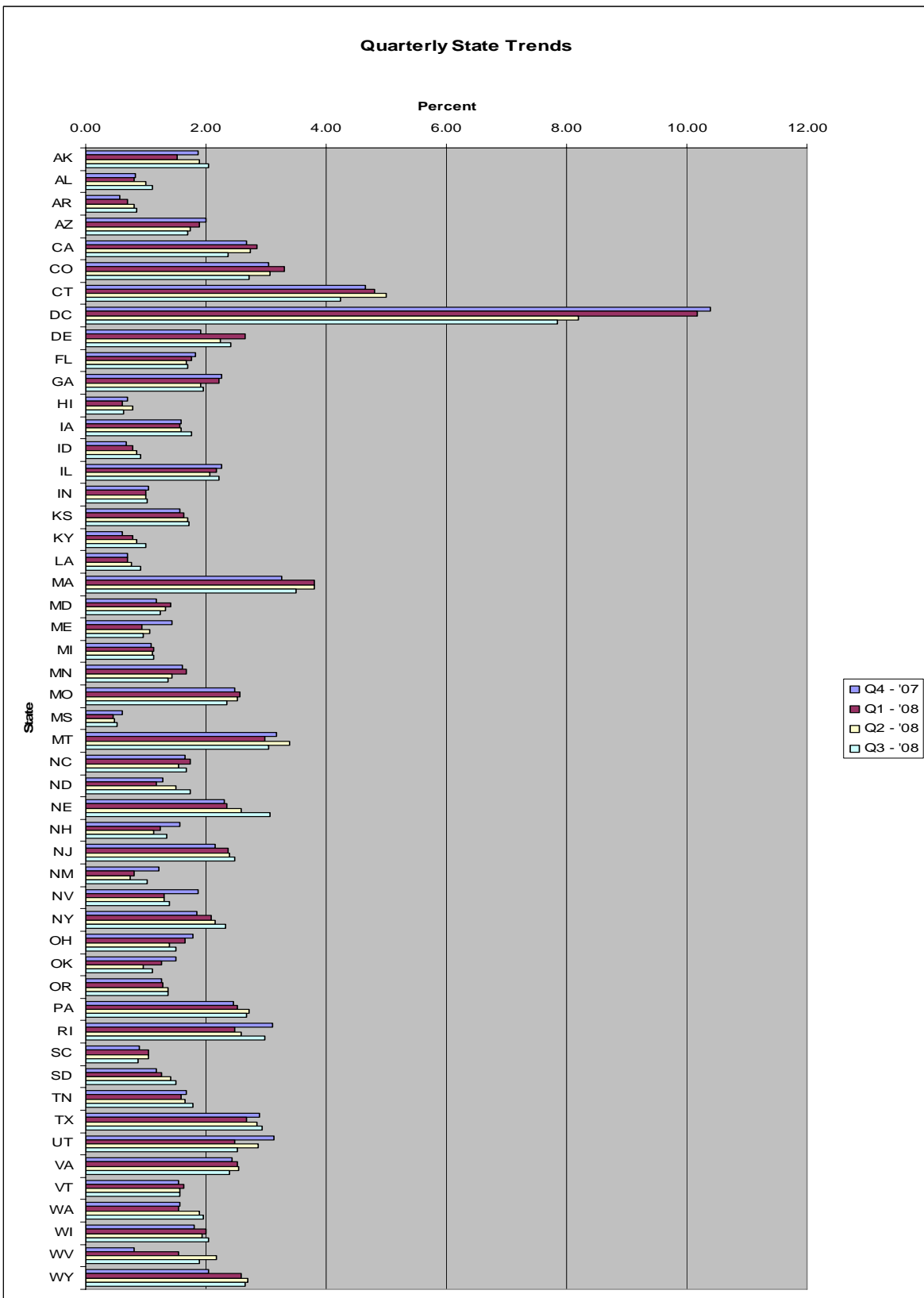


Figure 2-Quarterly State Trends-Job Postings (Q407-Q308)

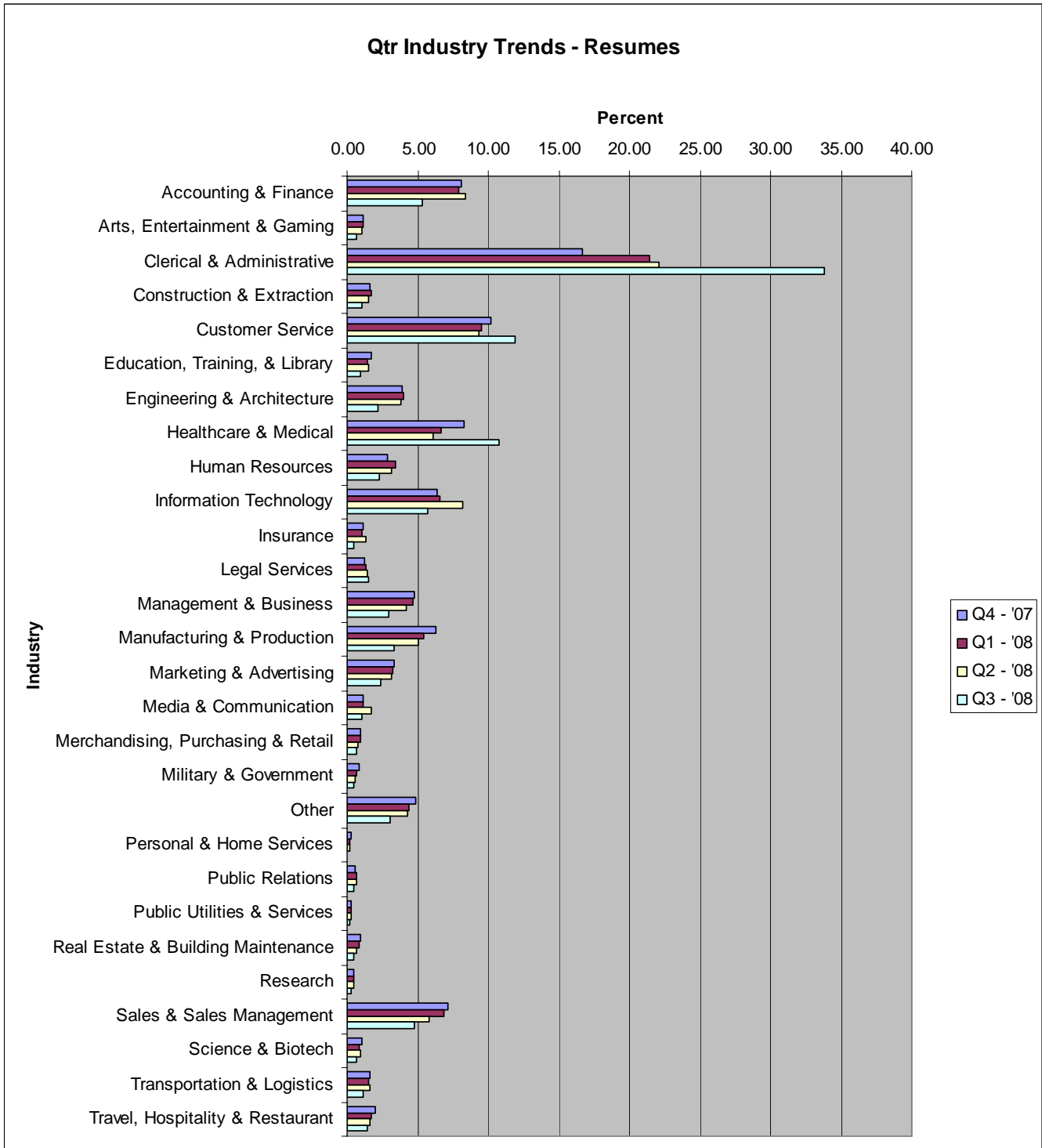


Figure 3-Resume Postings by Industry (Q407-Q308)

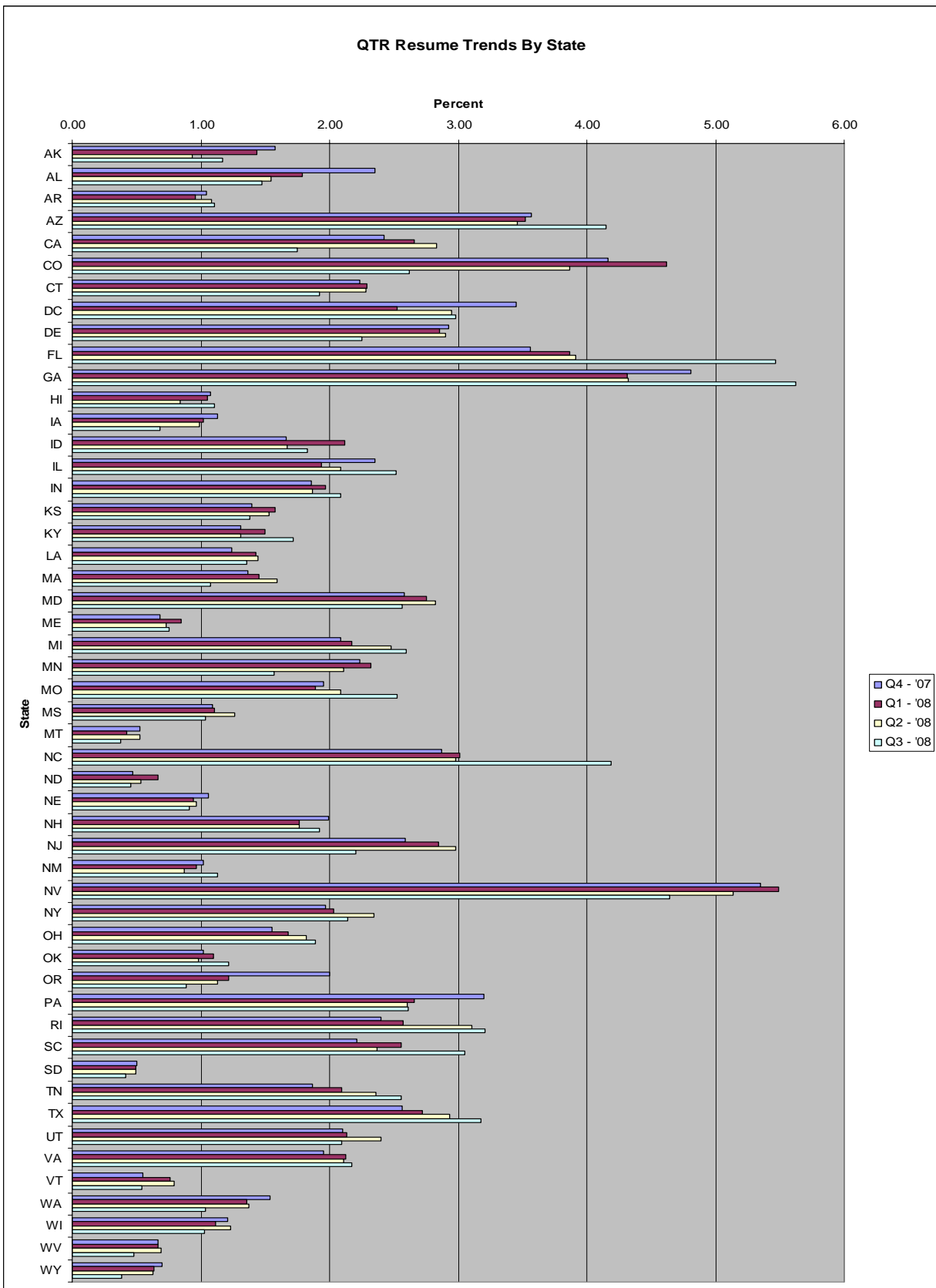


Figure 4-Quarterly State Trends-Resume Posting (Q407-Q308)
