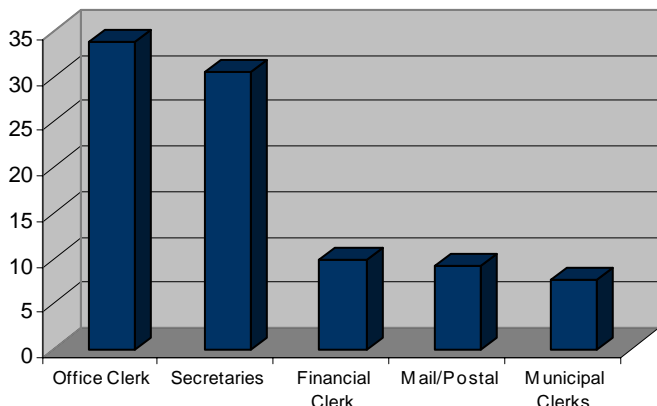


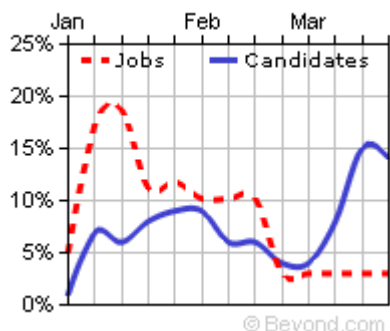

- Secretaries and administrative assistants will have among the largest numbers of new jobs arise, about 362,000 over the 2006-16 period.
