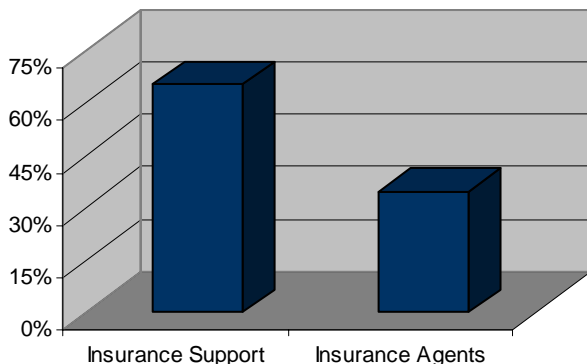
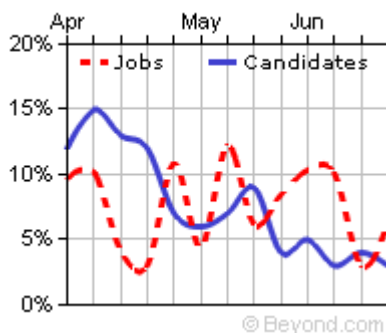


Insurance Channel 2Q08 Industry Outlook
