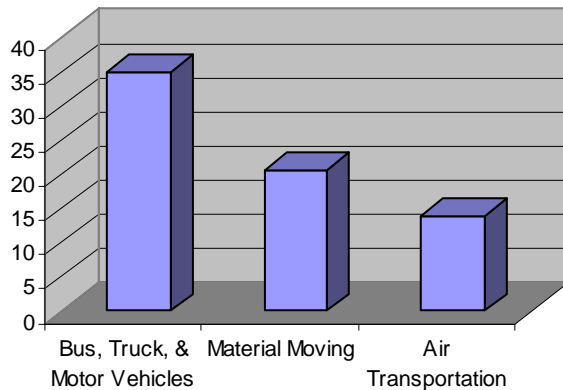
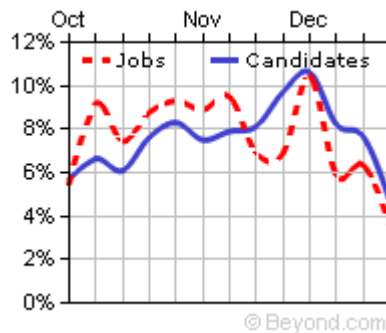


Candidate Breakdown – Percentage of Industry Transportation & Logistics
