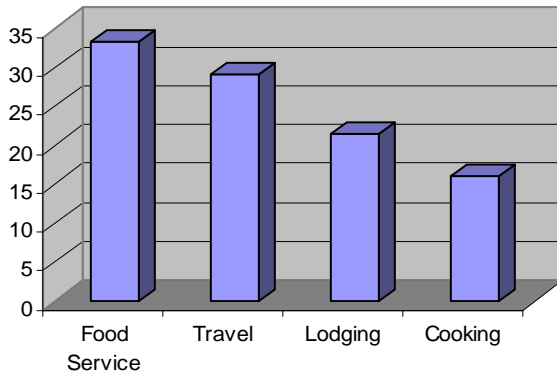
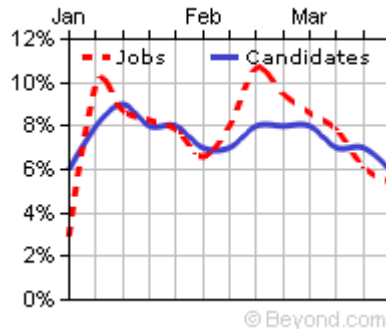


**Candidate Breakdown – Percentage of Industry
