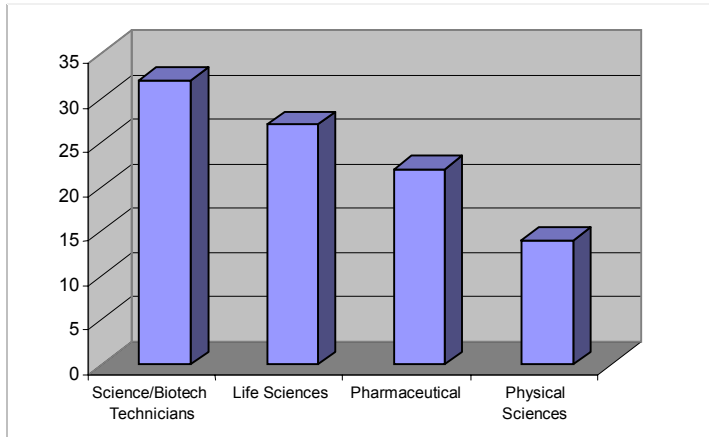
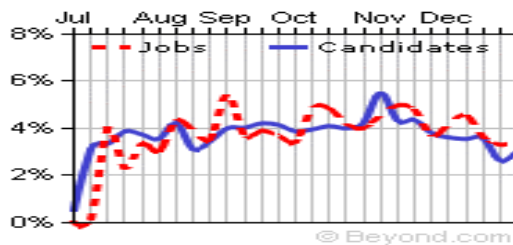


Top Candidate Sectors – Percentage of Industry Science & Biotechnology
